People love to gather and will find any reason to do so. This creates opportunities for us to witness for the Lord. However, we have also learned that there is a lack of desire to study the Word of God and grow in the knowledge of Jesus among believers.

Additionally, we have been teaching our body the importance of serving the Lord within the church. This is a very difficult concept for Christians here to understand. People are very friendly and kind, however, will not step out to serve within the church. We are discouraged at times; however, we press on knowing that God's Word will not return void, and it is a work of the Spirit to convince and change hearts. We are asking the Lord for wisdom, discernment, and patience as we navigate these issues. Please continue to pray for our body, that the Lord would give each person a hunger and thirst for Him; for growth and spiritual maturity as they seek the Lord through Bible study, prayer, and discipleship.

Calvary Peruíbe's one year church anniversary celebration in October was a blessed time of encouragement! It was a special service where Ewerton shared about the Lord's vision for Calvary Peruíbe, Pastor Celso from Calvary São Vicente taught the Word, followed by sweet fellowship and communion with our church family.

Children's ministry is growing – may the Lord send more servants for this very important ministry.
